## Classes and Numbers for next year

All students will spend the first day or days in their 2022 classes as we check school numbers and finalise the 2023 classes. This will be in the room that they ended the year, which may not be the class that they were in throughout the year. We will move into our 2023 classes and commence learning programs as soon as possible. We expect to maintain 25 classes again next year.

Transition for students moving into 2023 will be supported by teachers and leaders by building the student's capacity in dealing with change. Some students will receive a document to support their concerns, as required. For those who require it, a printed copy of a transition book will also be sent home for completion over the holiday break. We look forward to supporting all our children as they move into a new school year.

## Staff changes for 2023

In 2023, we will continue to fund a second Deputy Principal. Mr James Gray will be overseeing and supporting the primary grades, Years 3-6 and Ms Kristy West will be the Deputy Principal that will be supporting infant grades, Years K-2.

## Be At School Everyday

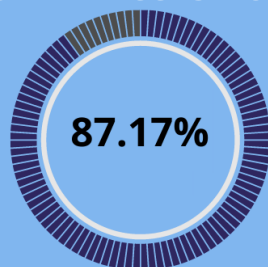

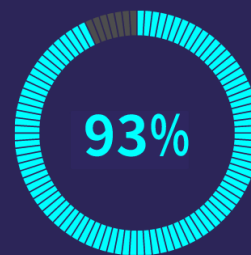
### Every Day Counts

stories and symbolism you have created; we definitely have some talented Aboriginal artists.

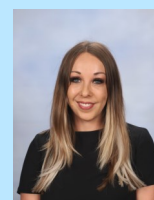
